Make sure all entries are marked as to whether they are Large Fowl or Bantams, Bearded or Non Bearded, Single or Rose Combed, etc.

All Entries Close on Friday, August 23, 2019 (postmarked)

All poultry except waterfowl must be pullorum-typhoid clean.
Please send a copy of your valid certificate if available with your entry.
